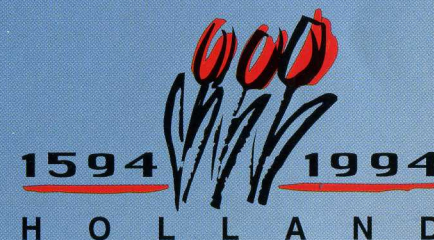

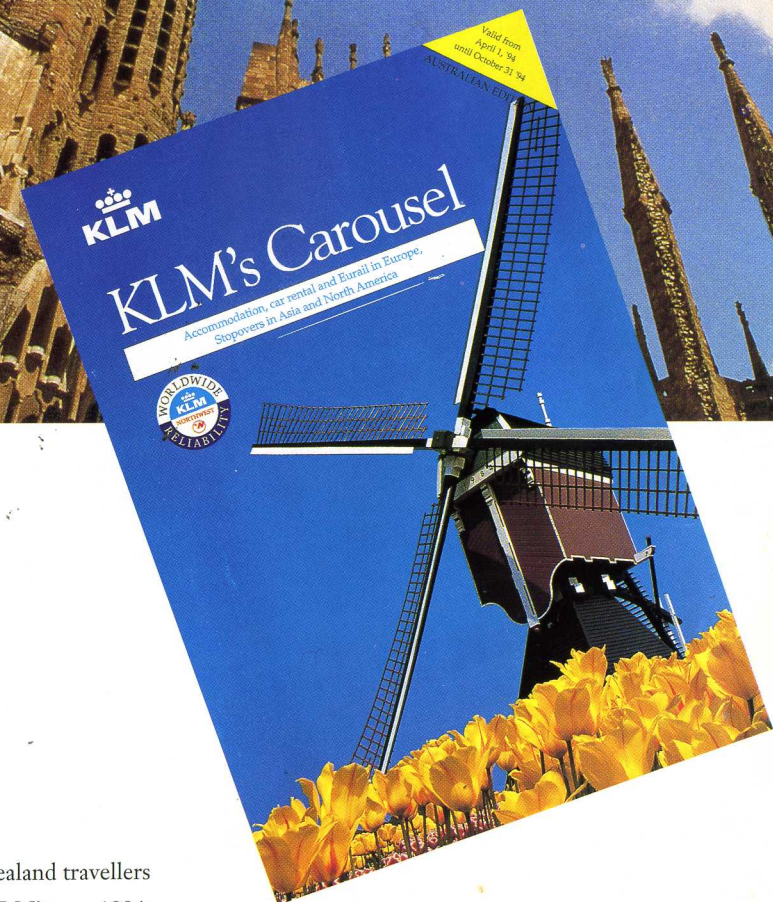

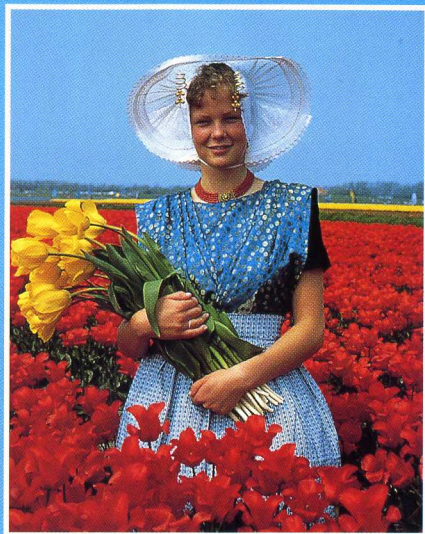

TULIP 400, KEUKENHOF, ALL OF 1994

VARIOUS LOCATIONS & KEUKENHOF

In 1994 the Dutch tulips celebrate their 400th anniversary. The first tulip flowered in Holland in the spring of 1594. Various activities are organised from live displays to art exhibitions. The Keukenhof, (opens 24 March to 23 May) the worlds largest bulb garden will have special displays besides its normal 28ha of flowering parkland.

HOLLAND FESTIVAL, ALL OF JUNE 1994

AMSTERDAM

The largest Dutch annual festival for the performing arts; Opera, Concerts, Dance and Theatre. Performed by Dutch and recognised international artists.

NORTH SEA JAZZ FESTIVAL, 8 TILL 10 JULY 1994

THE NETHERLANDS CONGRESS CENTRE, THE HAGUE

GEMEETE MUSEUM THE HAGUE

1994 will be the 50th anniversary of the Dutch painters death. This event will be marked by the Gemeete museum of Den Haag which has 251 of his works in their possession. Other paintings from New York and Washington will also be included.

X-RAYS REVEAL NINETEEN HIDDEN VAN GOGH PAINTINGS

APRIL 1994

The Van Gogh Museum has revealed the discovery of nineteen hidden works of Vincent Van Gogh, including works that were previously believed to be lost.

This exciting discovery was made during X-ray examination of some 130 Van Gogh canvasses. The hidden paintings date from 1880 when the artist lived in Nuenen, Arnhem and Paris.

Lack of materials is the probable explanation for painting over his works.



A remarkable find was a painting of Van Gogh's father's smoking equipment which he described in a letter, but was assumed lost. "The X-ray shows that it is indeed lost, but somewhat less definitely than had been thought", the museum said.

Vincent Van Gogh shot himself in 1888 at age 37 having sold only one painting in his lifetime.
