Located in Chester Hill, the Village was conceived in 1994 by the Dutch Community and was built with funds raised by them and further assisted through Federal and State grants. Accredited by The Standards Agency for Residential Care and Quality Monitoring for the Community Aged Care Packages, we continuously strive for best practice in all areas of service delivery. Currently we have 70 residential units and 58 home care packages for the elderly in the community.

Our residents are "Ageing in Place" and we have the resources to continue this care as care needs increase from Low to High Care and, where necessary, to Palliative Care. A secure 10 bed Dementia specific area is also available on site. The Link building has its own Nurses' station, thus providing additional security and reassurance for the residents that there is help close at hand 24 hours.
