PRESIDENT'S REPORT

It finally happened, weeks of hard work. The problem of stripping the old hall, and preparing our new Clubhouse, before the arrival of our trucks, cars, panel vans and trailers. I must admit having had some sleepless nights, thinking continuously did I forget something or someone, and knowing it is inevitable to strike some troubles and how to solve them as they come along.

Having to spend more time on paper work and in many Government offices, solicitors etc., made me realise how busy Mrs. Koevoets our Secretary Manager is. Welcome back Helen, although the sudden death of your father and your subsequent trip back home to your family made this trip a necessity, I can assure you that you were missed, and I especially would like to thank Mrs. Irene Newton for helping us out during this busy period.

While I was in the Chief Secretariat's office in Sydney, I was kindly informed to increase 2 more emergency exits, possibly 2 or more fire hose reels, emergency lightning system, all doors inside must be swinging both ways etc., so as you see we are not yet finished.

For the Members who do not have any idea what has been done, before we moved I will state the following as from the beginning.

After receiving the key of our new Clubhouse, work started immediately. Two walls were shifted to new locations. The whole club was washed down with sugar soap. Toilets and kitchen scrubbed down, one old bread oven removed and also one small oven, they were both in terrible condition. All windows cleaned, all the rooms and both halls repainted, Billiard room, restaurant and bar wall papered. The front of the bar rebuilt, beautiful tiles on the top of the counter, also on top of the kitchen cabinets, bar completely scrubbed down and painted, a beautiful counter and window fitted in the foyer. Two life size dolls in Dutch costume placed in the foyer. Lovely Dutch paintings donated for the walls in our Club. The roof was repaired, plumbing repairs. The dance floor recoated and waxed. All the carpets shampooed throughout the building. Electrical wiring and fittings repaired. Beautiful lettering placed outside on the front wall. Signwriting on our large sign post. Curtains washed and repaired, venetian blinds cleaned and repaired, additional curtains donated and made to measure. Table cloths made for our restaurant tables. All locks repaired fitted and recoded. Compressor units, airconditioning, water pumps tested repaired and overhauled, and all this in just 3 weeks.

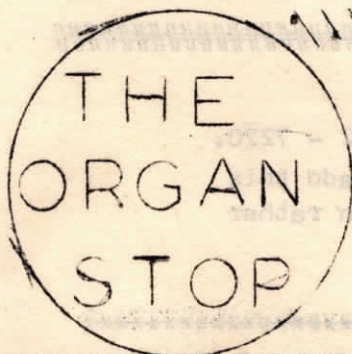

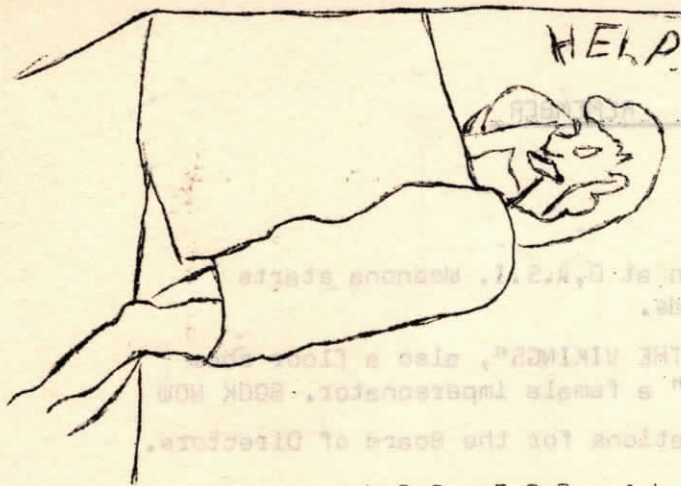
