Dr Ray Kerkhove is a professional historian and ethno-historian (accredited through PHAQ), specializing in 19<sup>th</sup> Century Aboriginal social history, conflict history (frontier wars) and material culture, mostly for Queensland. He is a casual researcher and sessional lecturer for University of Southern Queensland's Education Department (where he is an Adjunct Associate Professor); University of Queensland's Social Sciences Department (Archaeology School) and University of Queensland's Department of Architecture (Aboriginal Environments Research Centre). He is also an Associate of the Australian Centre for Genocide Studies.

Between 2004 and 2007, Ray worked as Resource Officer for a region-wide disability service, SPIRAL Inc. He was instrumental in developing the annual 'Celebration of Abilities' festival; obtaining funding for the organisation's new centre; and helping organise and obtain funding for a range of disability arts project and equipment.

From 2007 to 2011, Ray was Project Manager of the non-for-profit organisation he originated: *Interactive Community Planning Australia Inc* (ICP Aust Inc) – an arm of the cultural heritage company ICP Inc. He established this body to help progress any Indigenous project (mostly in Queensland but also nationally) of a specifically cultural or historical nature. This meant locating funding and organising the logistics for a wide variety of Indigenous-led initiatives. Working closely with Aboriginal communities, Ray and his organisation completed over 30 projects including regional events, book publishing, youth events, exhibitions, film documentaries, oral histories, cultural and language revival projects.

In 2010, Ray was co-recipient of the *Helen Taylor Award for Local History*, and in 2011, his ICP Aust Inc won the Governor's Gold Award from the *National Trust of Queensland*, for promoting local heritage. In 2017 Ray developed the first digital mapping of Aboriginal resistance history for Queensland, for Griffith University. He was also instrumental in organising the first Professional Development Day on the 'Frontier Wars' for Queensland Secondary School Teachers. He has twice served as a Visiting Fellow (with Griffith University) and twice as Historian-in-Residence.

Today, Ray's key expertise is reconstructing Aboriginal site use/ site histories (including conflict sites) and lifestyles. Ray's work regularly informs thematic Indigenous histories for Councils and Museums, Master Plans for towns, public artworks, exhibitions, public (Council) signage, and cultural revitalisation projects. For example, his research was utilised for *QUT Campus to Country – Positioning Strategy* (2020), which won the 2021 National Commendation for Urban Design. He is also currently assisting Eumundi Museum developing Indigenous heritage themes.

Additionally, Kerkhove sometimes writes in the field of Studies in Religion (comparative religions) – especially multi-faith history and smaller or more obscure religions. This develops on his MA thesis on Aztec religion, and his Doctoral thesis on the biography of Meher Baba. The latter study involved Ray visiting and residing in Indian and Australian Meher Baba centres, and authoring introductory booklets. Subsequently, Ray wrote one of the first multi-faith histories for an Australian region: *Soul Havens* (2003) and initiated *Seeking the Centre* – Noosa Gallery's multi-faith art exhibition and festival, which ran for two years. Currently Ray has been assisting with University of *Queensland's Queensland Atlas of Religion*.
