- 02-01-1909 born in Arnhem, The Netherlands.
- 27-02-1929 Navy Airforce Willemsoord, flight engineer H 3 e class.
- 01-05-1929 Navy Airforce, flight engineer 2 nd class.
- 18-05-1931 Navy Detachment Netherlands East Indies (NEI) .
- 10-06-1931 Travelled on the SS Johan van Oldenbarnevelt to Bandung (service number 89318).
- 18-05-1936 Renewed his sign-up period for 6 years (NEI V.Kl. brig. titulaire).
- 05-04-1938 Travelled on the SS Johan van Oldenbarnevelt to Amsterdam.
- 01-07-1938 Colonial reserve barracks Nijmegen temporary (sergeant).
- 01-08-1938 Address: Straalmanstraat 5 Nijmegen.
- 29-03-1939 Travelled on MS Dempo to Tandjok Priok (95150) to Malang, the service number is a missing page in Dutch national archive.
- 06-04-1939 Decoration 1661/C from kingdom of Belgium (according to archive Brussels, had something to do with transportation, referred to archives of the Dutch King).
- 01-05-1941 Son C.J. Trijssenaar born.
- 01-05-1941 Stayed at an officer's home in Bandung according to address book Ambon 1941. Reserve officer NL Army, based at NEI he was now a Sergeant Major at a military administration.
- 17-05-1942 End of military service.
- 00-00-1946 Civil Registration number Batavia, number 1646.
- 00-00-1947 Commonwealth list I.W.C.G.
- 13-04-1948 Deceased Ambon 30-01-1942 announcement Red Cross no. v/759/c.
- 06-05-1949 Deceased Ambon 01-02-1942 announcement O.d.o no. 4327 grave 1035 or 1635.
- 16-06-1949 Mother C.A. Trijssenaar asks the Dutch government information about her son.
- 00-00-1964 Letter from Dutch War Cemetery Organisation with picture of the Galala grave.
- 00-00-1973 Place of birth of his son C.J. Trijssenaar 01-05-1941 is Amboina stated by the government.
